Private Membership Association Charter

This Charter establishes a Private Membership Association (PMA) under the protections of the First and Ninth Amendments to the Constitution of the United States of America.

Article I: Name

This association shall be known as [Association Name], a private membership association of free men.

Article II: Purpose

The Association is formed for the lawful purpose of associating, sharing, educating, exchanging goods or services, and exercising spiritual, economic, or cultural freedom in the private domain.

Article III: Membership

Membership is voluntary, by invitation or application, and open to men who agree to abide by the private policies and peaceful intentions of the Association.

Article IV: Jurisdiction

This PMA operates entirely in the private domain under common law and natural law. It does not operate as a public accommodation or participate in regulated commerce.

Article V: Governance

The affairs of the PMA shall be managed by its trustees or designated members. All decisions shall be guided by peace, truth, honor, and mutual agreement.
